Getting Started with Zinio eMagazines

To get started, you need to create two accounts. One to borrow magazines, and one to read them.

1. Go to www.zinio.com and **Sign Up** for an account.
2. Go to www.rbdigital.com/windsoron and **Create a New Account**.

Tip: Be sure to use the same email address for both accounts. You will need a Library Card and PIN.

Borrowing Magazines:

3. From inside the **Windsor Public Library Zinio Magazine Collection** (www.rbdigital.com/windsoron) click on the **checkout now** icon (lower right corner) of the issue that you would like to borrow.
**To see back issues, click on the cover.*
4. If you would like to read the magazine right away through your Internet Browser (Chrome, Internet Explorer, etc.) click on **Start Reading**. If you would like to borrow more magazines, click on **Keep Browsing**.

Tip: There is no limit on how many you can checkout, and they do not expire.

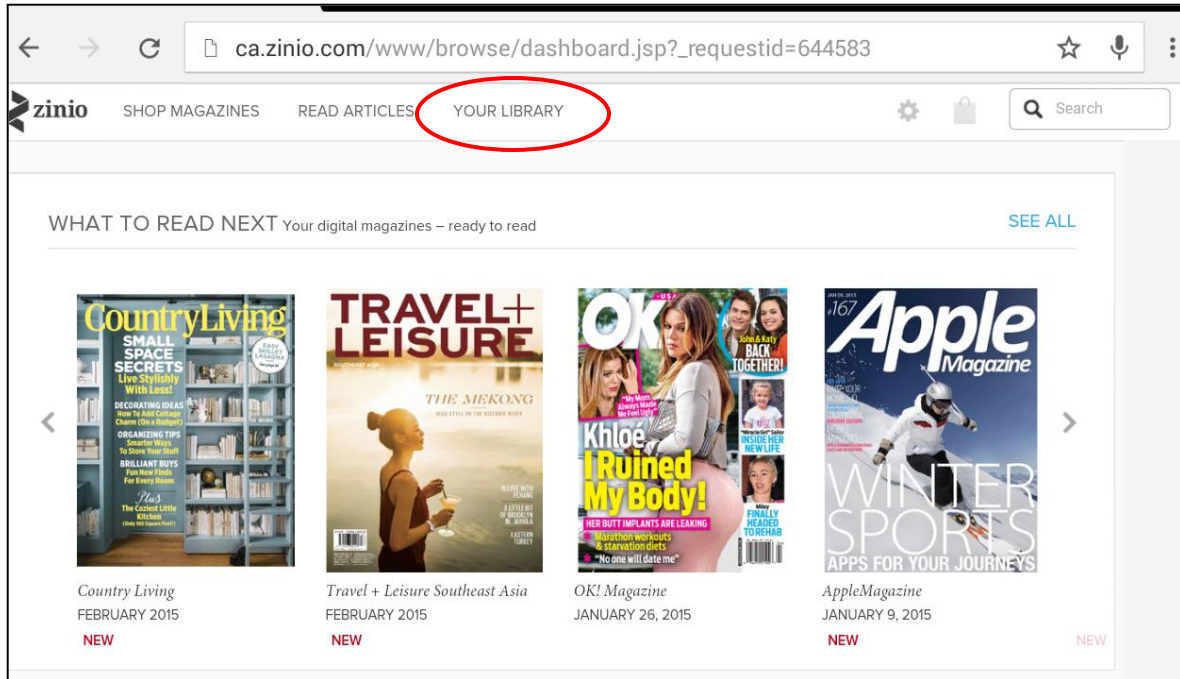

Reading Borrowed Magazines on your Computer

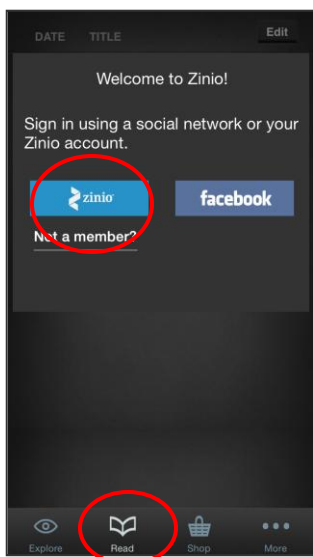
You can read magazines on your computer through your Zinio Reader account; this is called online streaming.

1. Go to www.rbdigital.com/windsoron and Login
2. Click on **Start Reading** (upper right corner)
3. This will take you to Zinio.com – Log in again
4. Click on **Your Library** – this will bring up all of the magazines that you have Checked Out.
5. Click on a cover to start reading.



Reading Borrowed Magazines on your Tablet or Smart Phone

If you have a tablet or smart phone, you can download magazines to read offline through the Zinio App. Once you have downloaded a magazine, you do not have to be connected to the Internet to read it.



1. Install the **Zinio App** from the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android)
2. Open the App, and tap on the **Read** icon.
3. Sign in using the same email address you used to create your accounts.
4. Once signed in, the magazines you checked out will be available to download under the Read tab.

Note: The App is for reading only. To borrow more magazines, return to www.rbdigital.com/windsoron.
