Question: Where was the first Windsor City Hall located?

Response:

The building identified as Windsor's first city hall was located on Sandwich Street (what is now Riverside Drive East) between Windsor Avenue and Mercer Street. Built in 1856, it served as city hall until 1904. (Pictured, Right)

After 1904, the former Central Public School, situated where the current City Hall is, was taken over by the City of Windsor.
